



THRILLING ATTRACTIONS

Save over 50% on admission to some of Tampa Bay's top attractions with **CityPASS**. At **Busch Gardens® Tampa Bay**, take on the Serengeti Flyer, reaching speeds of 68 mph and a maximum height of 135 feet at the ride's peak, making it the world's tallest and fastest ride of its kind. Meet native animals at **The Florida Aquarium's** Florida Wetlands Trail, interact with moon jellyfish at the Moon Bay exhibit, and hear how Atlantic Coral is being reproduced for the first time. Plus, new habitats for puffins and African penguins and an outdoor exhibit for California sea lions are on the horizon. Come face-to-face with Florida manatees at **ZooTampa at Lowry Park**, where a multimillion-dollar habitat has expanded the ability to treat injured or sick Florida manatees.

RETAIL THERAPY

Come get your retail fix. The region's premiere shopping destination, **International Plaza & Bay Street**, offers 200+ luxury brands and exciting restaurants like **Alma Restaurant & Bar** and **Whiskey Cake** in a colorful outdoor restaurant village. Beautiful, open-air shopping neighborhood, **Hyde Park Village**, features a collection of high-end retailers and restaurants. THE TAMPA RIVERWALK

The 2.6-mile (4 km) **Tampa Riverwalk** links together some of downtown Tampa's most popular attractions, hotels, museums and parks like gems on a string. At one end, visit **Sparkman Wharf**, a popular outdoor food hall on the Tampa Bay waterfront. Stroll to the other end of the Riverwalk to **Armature Works** and the **Heights Public Market**, which houses over 18 unique dining options. Looking for good food with an even better view? Watch the sunset on the Tampa Bay waterfront from **Ulele** or the **Sail Plaza**. Hop on the popular **Pirate Water Taxi** and explore downtown Tampa from the water on their fleet of yellow and black vessels.



HISTORIC YBOR CITY

"Hav-a-Tampa" cigar and see how Historic Ybor City turned Tampa into the Cigar Capital of the World. Today, skilled tabaqueros still roll cigars by hand. Enjoy the live music while sipping a café con leche or enjoy one of the district's signature restaurants or nightclubs. Sample the official sandwich of the City of Tampa, the original **Cuban Sandwich**, which was invented specifically for Ybor City cigar rollers. Visit Cuba without a passport by stepping through the gates of **José Martí Park**, where the land has been owned by the Cuban people since the 1950s in honor of the famed Cuban revolutionary fighter. Since 1905, **The Columbia Restaurant**, Florida's Oldest Restaurant™ has been serving award-winning Spanish/Cuban cuisine and an internationally acclaimed wine list. **The Official Ybor City Walking Tours** keep the neighborhood's history and influence alive. Be sure to keep an eye – and an ear – out for Ybor City's oldest residents, wild chickens that strut through the streets.
